

Food Web and Food Chain Activity

Below is a list of organisms which are common in this area.

Food Chain Activity: Take the animals from the column on the left and place them in the food chain on the right. Place the organism in the highest level in which it interacts with the others. More than one organism can be placed in each of the trophic levels.

Food Web Activity: On a separate sheet of paper construct a food web using the organism you used to create the food chain. Arrange the organisms in a way so that you have the fewest crossed lines (this makes it less confusing). Hint; use a pencil so that you can easily correct mistakes.
